14. The Dean of Students' Welfare.—(1) The Dean of Students' Welfare shall be appointed by the Vice—Chancellor for a period of two years from amongst the University Professors, Readers or Principals:

(2) The duties, powers and functions of the Dean of Students' Welfare shall

be prescribed by the Statutes.

(5) The teacher appointed as the <sup>1</sup>[Dean, Students' Welfare] under subsection (1) shall hold lien on his original post, and he shall be eligible for all the benefits which would have off-erwise accrued to him, in case he would not have been appointed as <sup>2</sup>[Dean, Students' Welfare].
