- The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution
- The management of the Institution shall not discontinue any course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
- No excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- The Institution shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any other Indian and / or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution
- The Institution shall not conduct any course(s) as specified in the Approval Process Handbook without prior permission / approval of AICTE. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- The Institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers / extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution / university / organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- The accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or persons authorized by it.
- Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in given time frame and selection shall be done according to

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procedures, qualifications and assessment procedures by the Council from time to time and may include any or all the items mentioned by the AICTE from time to time. The Institute shall submit to the Council a copy of the procedures and guidelines of the programme under going details regarding the Institute and students / programme being conducted. The Institute shall also submit to the Council the information including details of the form of operation, structure. The information available may be made available to the stakeholders of the educational institution. The Institute shall submit information to the Registrar to the AICTE within specified time frame. The information shall be available to the Council. The information shall be submitted to the Registrar to the AICTE within specified time frame.

41. It shall be mandatory for the Institute to submit a report regarding the assessment information. The available information shall be submitted to the Registrar to the AICTE within specified time frame.
42. In the Registrar, Ministry of HRD, Government of India, the information shall include the following information submitted to Council of the Institute to be submitted.

1. Department wise availability of infrastructure along with approved courses and details approved by the Council
2. Faculty, Staffs, Management and financial details of the Institute, including details of the staff and their qualifications details of various projects undertaken. All appropriate facilities should be disclosed during the process.
3. Additional, Staffs, Financial Statement for each financial year to be submitted.

43. The Institute shall submit the information to the Council and to the Registrar to the AICTE within specified time frame. The information shall be submitted to the Registrar to the AICTE within specified time frame.

44. AICTE may, after consultation with the Institute, submit a report regarding the Institute to the Council of the Institute to be submitted to the Registrar to the AICTE within specified time frame.
